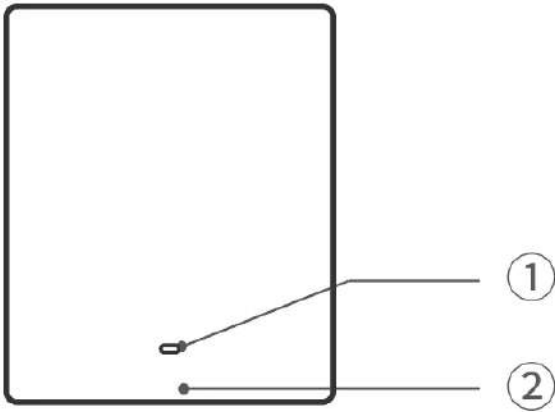

eWeLink Ecosystem:

- Flashes two short and one long: Device is in pairing mode.
- Keeps on: Online.
- Slow flash once: Offline.
- Flashes twice: LAN.

Matter Ecosystem:

- Flashes two short and one long: Device is in pairing mode.
- Keeps on: Online.
- Slow flash once: Offline.

② Button

- Single press: Turn on/off the smart device.
- Press and hold for 5 seconds: Device enters the pairing mode. (Pairing time 10 minutes)

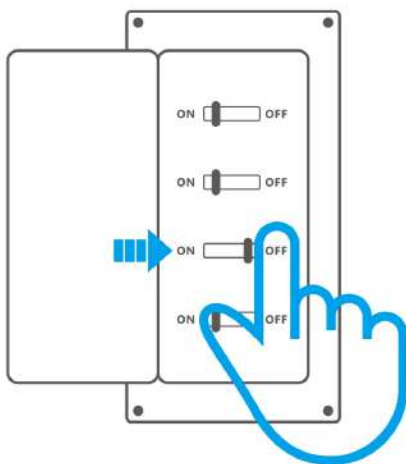

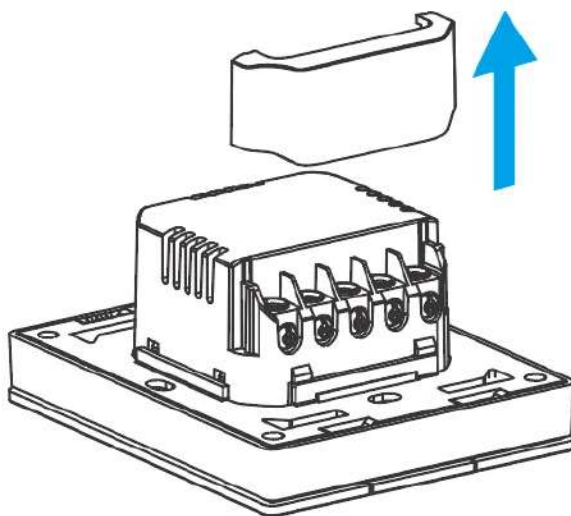
1. Power off



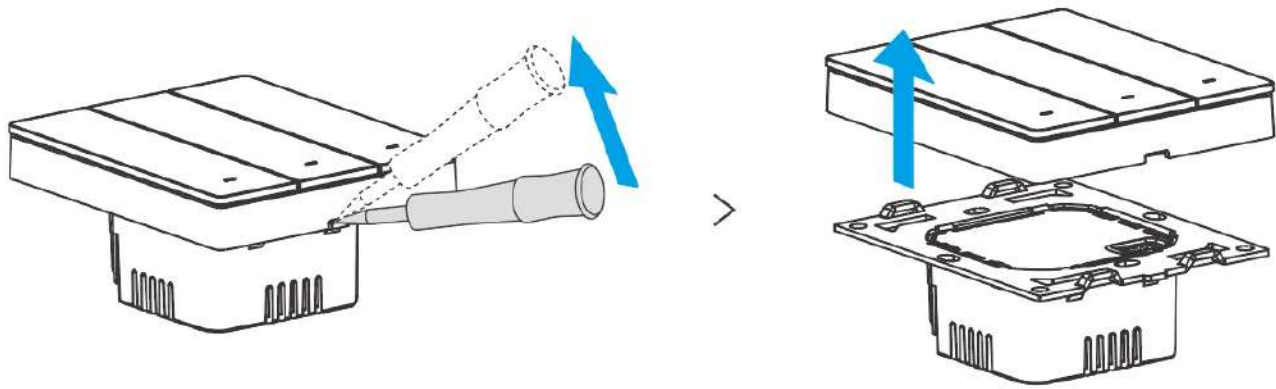

2. Remove the protective cover



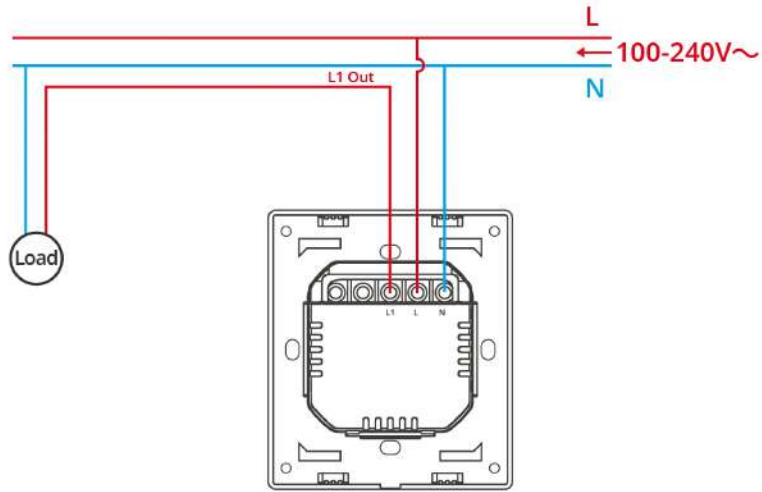

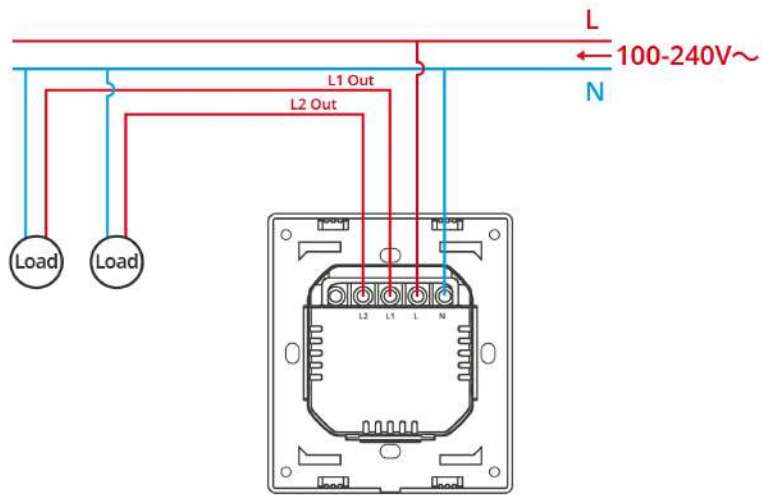
4. Wiring instructions

⚠ To ensure the safety of your electrical installation, it's essential either a Miniature Circuit Breaker (MCB) or a Residual Current operated Circuit-breaker with Integral Overcurrent protection (RCBO) with an electrical rating of 6A, 10A has been installed before the M5-1C-80M(10A), M5-1C-80W(10A), M5-2C-80M(10A), M5-2C-80W(10A), M5-3C-80W(6A), M5-3C-80M(6A).

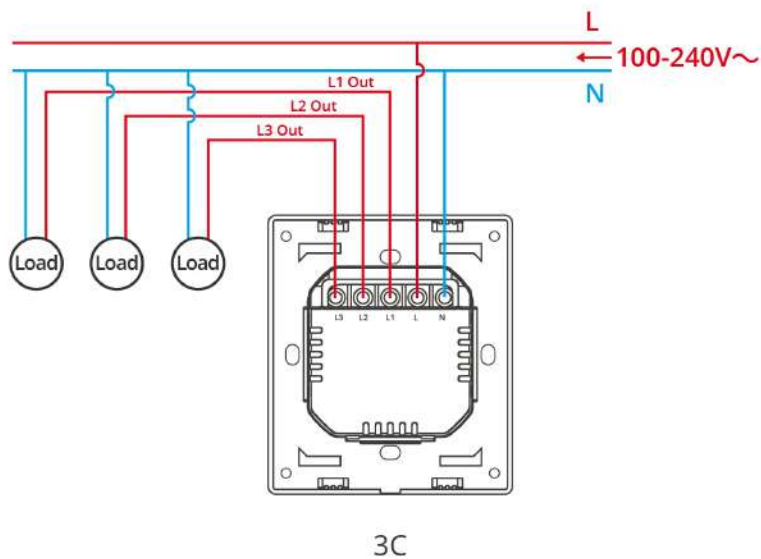
⚠ Make sure all wires are connected correctly.

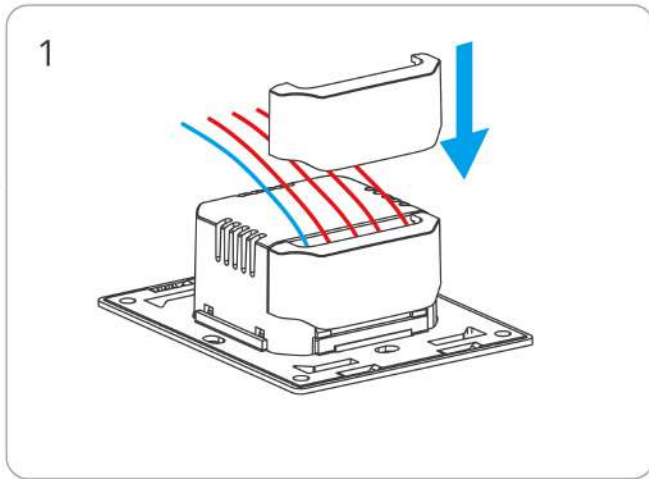

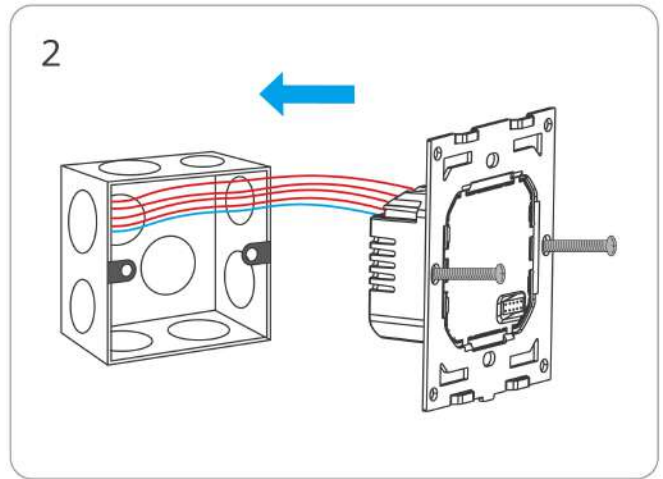

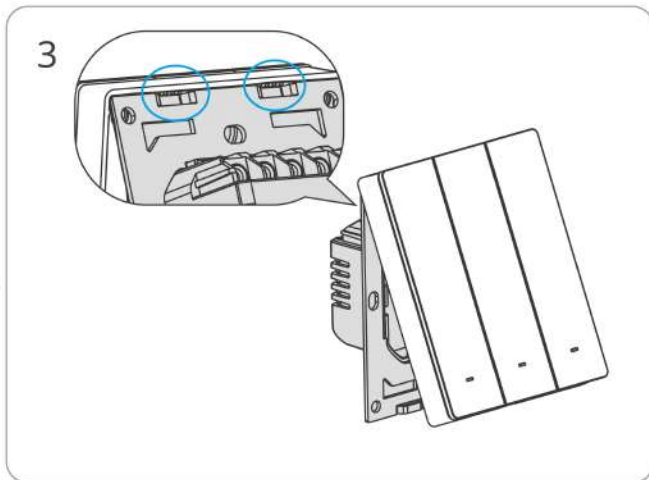
5. Install the device into the mounting box



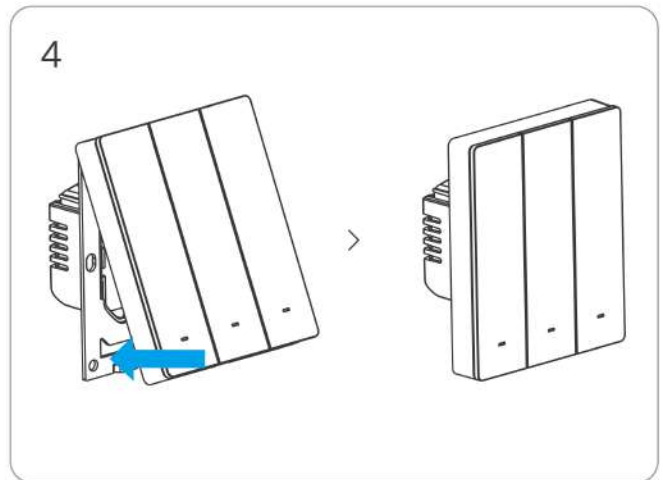
Install the protective cover.



Tighten the power module to the mounting box with screws.



Hook the switch module's latch into the upper groove of the metal frame.



Press downward to fix the switch module in place, it will automatically align with the pin positions.

⚠ When the wall-mounting box is made of plastic and the size is small, the protective cover can be omitted.

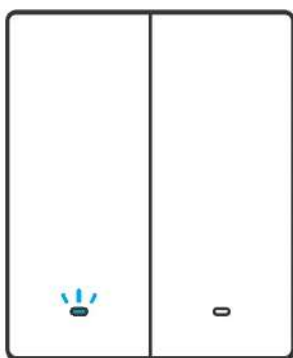
⚠ This device can be used with the SONOFF switch frame.

6. Power on

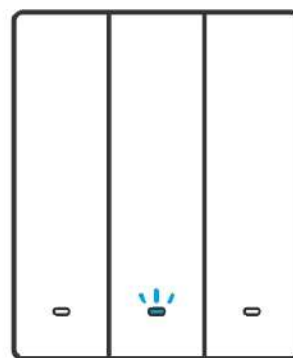
After powering on, the device will enter "pairing mode" during the first use. The LED indicator changes in a cycle of two short and one long flash and release.

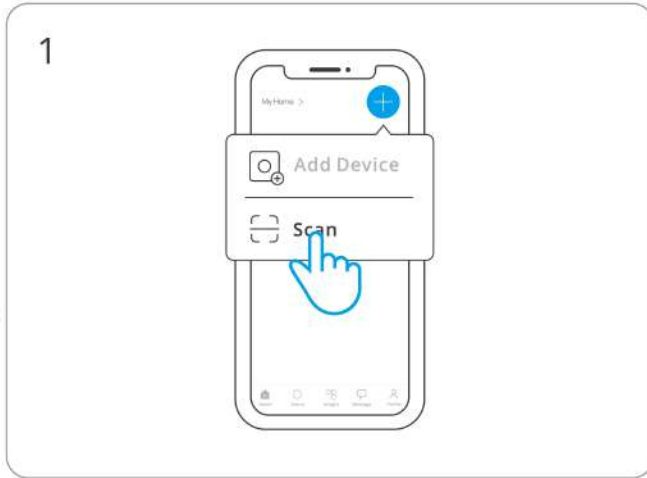

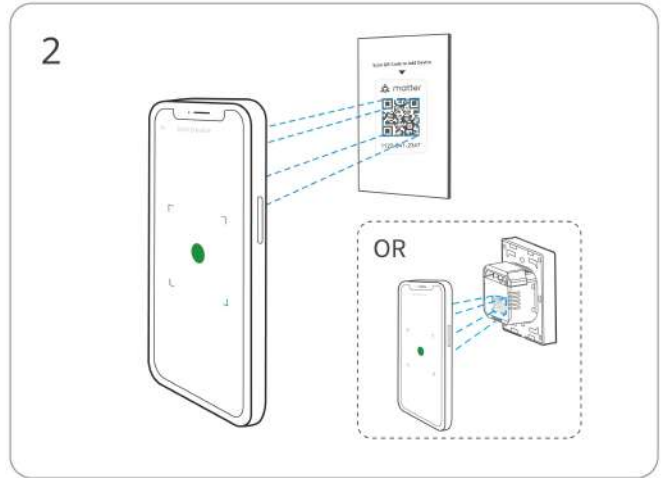

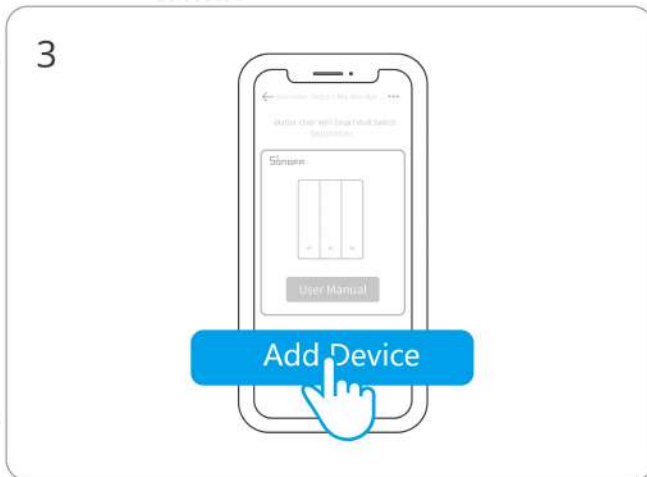
2. Scan QR code to add the device



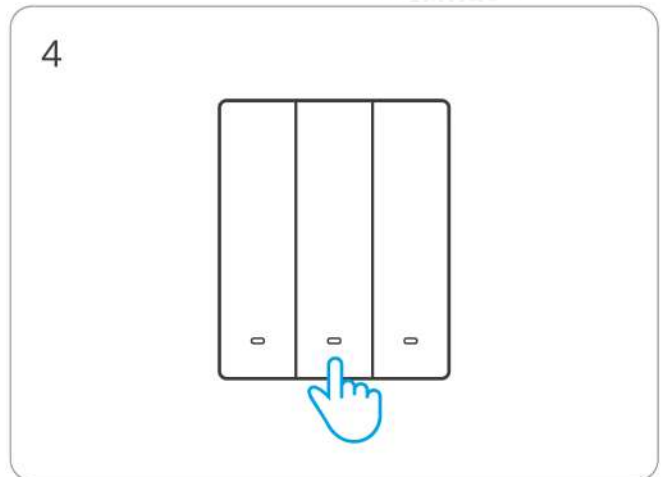
